16 TO AMEND ARKANSAS LAW CONCERNING THE
17 NUMBER OF AUTHORIZED VEHICLES FOR THE
18 DEPARTMENT OF INFORMATION SYSTEMS; AND TO
19 DECLARE AN EMERGENCY.

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
23

24 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 19-4-906(a)(084), concerning the maximum
25 number of authorized vehicles for the Department of Information Systems, is
26 amended to read as follows:

27 (084) Department of Information ~~Services~~ Systems 7 14
28

29 SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
30 General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that a recent audit recommended
31 that the Department of Information Systems consider purchasing additional
32 state vehicles as needed for employees that travel extensively; that the
33 purchase of additional vehicles as recommended will reduce mileage and rental
34 vehicle costs for the department; and that this act should become effective
35 immediately to generate a more efficient and cost-effective use of state
36 resources. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and this act being



1 immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and
2 safety shall become effective on:

3 (1) The date of its approval by the Governor;

4 (2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,
5 the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the
6 bill; or

7 (3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
8 overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
