EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the 21 22 General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the statewide equal and 23 uniform application of the homestead property tax credit is required by the Arkansas Constitution; that current law does not create a system that is 24 25 equal and uniform; and that this act corrects the current law to ensure a 26 statewide equal and uniform application of the homestead property tax credit. 27 Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall 28 29 become effective on: 30 (1) The date of its approval by the Governor; (2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, 31 32 the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill; or 33 34 (3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is 35 overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto. 36

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
