16 TO AMEND THE ARKANSAS MEDICAL MARIJUANA
17 AMENDMENT OF 2016 TO PROHIBIT

24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

26 SECTION 1. Pursuant to § 23 of Arkansas Constitution, Amendment 98,
27 also known as the "Arkansas Medical Marijuana Amendment of 2016", Arkansas
28 Constitution, Amendment 98, § 2(19), concerning the definition of "written
29 certification" within the Arkansas Medical Marijuana Amendment of 2016, as
30 amended by Acts 2017, No. 5, is amended to add an additional subdivision to
31 read as follows:

32 (C) A physician shall not issue a written certificate to a
33 patient based on an assessment performed through telemedicine.
