8 AN ACT TO REAPPROPRIATE THE BALANCES OF CAPITAL
9 IMPROVEMENT APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF
10 HUMAN SERVICES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

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13 AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN
14 SERVICES REAPPROPRIATION.
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18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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SECTION 1. REAPPROPRIATION - BOONEVILLE HUMAN DEVELOPMENT CENTER.

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21 There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Human Services - Division
22 of Developmental Disabilities Services, to be payable from the federal funds
23 as designated by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, for the Department of
24 Human Services - Division of Developmental Disabilities Services the
25 following:

26 (A) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided
27 in Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 222 of 2017, for implementation of the
28 initial phase of the Booneville Human Development Center master plan
29 including costs associated with demolition, construction, replacement,
30 renovation, upgrade and addition of facilities at the Booneville Human
31 Development Center, in a sum not to exceed\$1,893,820.
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33 SECTION 2. REAPPROPRIATION - DIRECTOR'S OFFICE. There is hereby
34 appropriated, to the Department of Human Services - Director's Office, to be
35 payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund
36 accounts, for the Department of Human Services - Director's Office the

2 (A) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided
3 in Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 229 of 2017, for various maintenance,
4 renovation, equipping, construction, acquisition, improvement, upgrade and
5 repair of real property and facilities department-wide, in a sum not to
6 exceed\$10,000,000.
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8 SECTION 3. REAPPROPRIATION - ADDITIONAL MEDICAID FUNDING - GRANT

9 PAYMENTS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Human Services
10 - Division of Medical Services, to be payable from the General Improvement
11 Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the Department of Human
12 Services - Division of Medical Services the following:

13 (A) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided
14 in Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 230 of 2017, for grant payments of the
15 Arkansas Medicaid Program of the Department of Human Services - Division of
16 Medical Services - Grants, in a sum not to exceed\$90,000,000.
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18 SECTION 4. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor
19 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects
20 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available
21 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and
22 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and
23 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or
24 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State
25 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects
26 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds
27 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General
28 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall
29 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

30 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State
31 Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the
32 Revenue Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of
33 this State and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and
34 Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in
35 disbursement of any funds provided by this act unless specifically provided
36 otherwise by law.

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SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE. This act is effective on and after July 1, 2018.
