6	(2) The rules, regulations, and standards shall include, but		
7	shall not be limited to, the following specific matters:		
8	(A) The number of licensed pharmacists and other hospital		
9	pharmacy technicians and the scope of duties to be performed by the hospital		
10	pharmacy technicians in the inpatient medication distribution system, in		
11	keeping with the size and scope of the services of the hospital and its		
12	hospital pharmacy and the hospital pharmacy's safe, efficient, and economical
