8 AN AMENDMENT TO THE ARKANSAS CONSTITUTION CONCERNING  
9 THE DUTIES OF THE COMMISSIONER OF STATE LANDS,

15 AN AMENDMENT TO THE ARKANSAS CONSTITUTION  
16 CONCERNING THE DUTIES OF THE COMMISSIONER  
17 OF STATE LANDS, AUDITOR OF STATE, AND  
18 LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR.

21 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NINETY-SECOND GENERAL  
22 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, AND BY THE SENATE, A MAJORITY OF ALL  
23 MEMBERS ELECTED TO EACH HOUSE AGREEING THERETO:

25 That the following is proposed as an amendment to the Constitution of  
26 the State of Arkansas, and upon being submitted to the electors of the state  
27 for approval or rejection at the next general election for Representatives  
28 and Senators, if a majority of the electors voting thereon at the election  
29 adopt the amendment, the amendment shall become a part of the Constitution of  
30 the State of Arkansas, to wit:

32 SECTION 1. The purpose of this joint resolution is to propose an  
33 amendment to the Arkansas Constitution concerning the duties of the  
34 Commissioner of State Lands, Auditor of State, and Lieutenant Governor and to  
35 reduce the number of state constitutional officers.
