## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 AN ACT TO AMEND THE MAKEUP OF THE ARKANSAS LIVESTOCK  
9 AND POULTRY COMMISSION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

### Subtitle

11 TO AMEND THE MAKEUP OF THE ARKANSAS  
12 LIVESTOCK AND POULTRY COMMISSION.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
18

19 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 2-33-102 is amended to read as follows:  
20 2-33-102. Members.

21 (a)(1) The Arkansas Livestock and Poultry Commission shall consist of  
22 seven (7) members who are residents and electors of this state to be  
23 appointed by the Governor by and with the advice and consent of the Senate  
24 for terms of seven (7) years and shall be actively engaged in the Arkansas  
25 livestock or poultry industries.

26 (2)(A) At least four (4) members shall be actively and  
27 principally engaged in animal agriculture production in Arkansas.

28 (B) The remaining members shall be at large and shall be  
29 actively engaged in the Arkansas livestock or poultry industry.

30 (b) Each congressional district shall be represented by membership on  
31 the commission.

32 (c) The term of office shall commence on January 15 following the  
33 expiration date of the preceding term and shall end on January 14 of the  
34 seventh year following the year in which the term commenced.

35 (d) Any vacancies arising in the membership of the commission for any  
36 reason other than expiration of the terms for which the members were



1 appointed shall be filled by appointment by the Governor and be effective  
2 until the expiration of the terms, subject to the confirmation of the Senate  
3 when it is next in session.

4 (e) Before entering upon his or her duties, ~~each~~ a member of the  
5 commission shall take, subscribe, and file in the office of the Secretary of  
6 State an oath to support the United States Constitution and the Arkansas  
7 Constitution and to faithfully perform the duties of the office upon which he  
8 or she is about to enter.

9 (f) Members of the commission shall receive no pay for their services,  
10 ~~Members of the commission~~ , but may receive expense reimbursement and  
11 stipends in accordance with § 25-16-901 et seq.
