9 AN ACT TO AMEND THE ELIGIBILITY OF FAMILY MEMBERS WHO
10 MAY APPLY FOR A GOLD STAR FAMILY SPECIAL LICENSE
11 PLATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.
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Subtitle

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17 TO AMEND THE ELIGIBILITY OF FAMILY
18 MEMBERS WHO MAY APPLY FOR A GOLD STAR
19 FAMILY SPECIAL LICENSE PLATE.
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22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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24 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-24-211 is amended to read as follows:
25 27-24-211. Gold Star Family special license plates – Definitions.

26 (a) The purpose of this section is to honor the family members of a
27 deceased service member.

28 (b) The Department of Finance and Administration is authorized to
29 issue one (1) Gold Star Family special license plate to an applicant who
30 establishes upon initial application that he or she is a family member of a
31 deceased service member.

32 (c) There is no cost for the issuance or renewal of the Gold Star
33 Family special license plate under this section.

34 (d)(1) The Department of Finance and Administration shall design the
35 Gold Star Family special license plates issued under this section as provided
36 under this subsection.



1 (2) The design of the Gold Star Family special license plate
 2 shall include a large gold star on the left-hand side of the Gold Star Family
 3 special license plate and a decal at the bottom of the plate that states
 4 "Gold Star Family" in lieu of the legend "The Natural State" or any
 5 succeeding legend.

6 (3) An additional decal that states "combat-related death" may
 7 be placed on the Gold Star Family special license plate if the deceased
 8 service member was killed in action.

9 (e) A Gold Star Family special license plate is not transferable as
 10 provided under § 27-24-207.

11 (f) The registration of a Gold Star Family special license plate under
 12 this section may continue from year to year so long as it is renewed each
 13 year within the time and the manner required by law.

14 (g)(1) A family member applying for a Gold Star Family special license
 15 plate authorized by subsection (b) of this section shall provide the
 16 Department of Finance and Administration with:

17 ~~(1) Evidence of the receipt of a Gold Star lapel button issued~~
 18 ~~by the United States Department of Defense under 10 U.S.C. § 1126; or~~

19 ~~(2) A copy of the final Leave and Earnings Statement issued to~~
 20 ~~the deceased service member showing that he or she was entitled to:~~

21 ~~(A) Hardship duty pay;~~

22 ~~(B) Hostile fire pay; or~~

23 ~~(C) Imminent danger pay.~~

24 (A) Documentation showing classification of death as
 25 listed by the United States Secretary of Defense;

26 (B)(i) A Report of Casualty form, DD Form 1300, or a
 27 Serious Incident Report issued by the United States Armed Forces.

28 (ii) If the person applying for the Gold Star Family
 29 special license plate is not listed on a report under subdivision
 30 (g)(1)(B)(i) of this section additional documentation shall be required by
 31 the Department of Finance and Administration to verify familial status,
 32 including without limitation a birth certificate or obituary; or

33 (C) Verification of eligibility for Dependency and
 34 Indemnity Compensation through the United States Department of Veterans
 35 Affairs, or other documentation which identifies a service-connected illness
 36 or injury as the cause of death of the deceased service member.

1 (2)(A) The Department of Finance and Administration may consult
2 with the Arkansas Department of Military regarding supporting documentation
3 that may be used by a family member to prove eligibility when applying for a
4 Gold Star Family special license plate.

5 (B) However, the Department of Finance and Administration shall
6 make the final decision as to whether or not the applicant is eligible to be
7 issued a Gold Star Family special license plate.

8 (h) As used in this section:

9 (1) “Deceased service member” means a member of the United
10 States Armed Forces who ~~died while serving in~~ was killed or died in the
11 honorable performance of his or her duty within one (1) year of receiving a
12 service-connected injury or contracting a service-connected illness; and

13 ~~(A) An area of conflict recognized by the United States~~
14 ~~Department of Defense;~~

15 ~~(B) A location that entitles the deceased service member~~
16 ~~to:~~

17 ~~(i) Hardship duty pay;~~

18 ~~(ii) Hostile fire pay; or~~

19 ~~(iii) Imminent danger pay;~~

20 (2) “Family member” means a spouse, parent, sibling, or child of
21 a member of the United States Armed Forces, including without limitation:

22 (A) A birthmother or birthfather;

23 (B) A stepmother or stepfather;

24 (C) An adoptive parent;

25 (D) A biological child;

26 (E) An adopted child; or

27 (F) A stepchild.

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
