23	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-SECOND GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE
24	STATE OF ARKANSAS, AND BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, A MAJORITY OF ALL
25	MEMBERS ELECTED TO EACH HOUSE AGREEING THERETO:

27	THAT the following is proposed as an amendment to the Constitution of
28	the State of Arkansas, and upon being submitted to the electors of the state
29	for approval or rejection at the next general election for Representatives
30	and Senators, if a majority of the electors voting thereon at the election
31	adopt the amendment, the amendment shall become a part of the Constitution of
32	the State of Arkansas, to wit:

34	SECTION 1. Arkansas Constitution, Article 5, § 5, is amended to read
35	as follows:
36	§ 5. Regular and fiscal sessions.



1 (a) The General Assembly shall meet at the seat of government every 2 year two (2) years. 3 (b) The General Assembly shall meet in regular session on the second 4 Monday in January of each odd-numbered year to consider any bill or 5 resolution. The General Assembly may alter the time at which the regular 6 session begins. 7 (c)(1) Beginning in 2010, the General Assembly shall meet in fiscal 8 session on the second Monday in February of each even-numbered year to 9 consider only appropriation bills. The General Assembly may alter the time 10 at which the fiscal session begins. 11 (2) A bill other than an appropriation bill may be considered in 12 a fiscal session if two-thirds (2/3) of the members of each house of the 13 General Assembly approve consideration of the bill. 14 (d) The General Assembly, by a vote of two-thirds (2/3) of the members 15 elected to each house of the General Assembly, may alter the dates of the 16 regular session and fiscal session so that regular sessions occur in even 17 numbered years and the fiscal sessions occur in odd-numbered years. 18 19 SECTION 2. Arkansas Constitution, Article 5, § 17, is amended to read 20 as follows: 21 § 17. Duration of sessions. 22 (a) A regular biennial session shall not exceed sixty (60) calendar 23 days in duration, unless extended by a vote of two-thirds (2/3) of the 24 members elected to each house of the General Assembly. The regular biennial 25 session shall not exceed seventy five (75) calendar days in duration, unless 26 extended by a vote of three-fourths $(\frac{3}{2})$ of the members elected to each house 27 of the General Assembly. 28 (b) A fiscal session shall not exceed thirty (30) calendar days in duration, except that by a vote of three-fourths (%) of the members elected 29 to each house of the General Assembly a fiscal session may be extended one 30 31 (1) time by no more than fifteen (15) calendar days. 32 (c)(b) Provided, that this section shall not apply when impeachments 33 are pending. 34 SECTION 3. Arkansas Constitution, Article 5, § 29, is amended to read 35 36 as follows:

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§ 29. Appropriations.

Except as provided in Arkansas Constitution, Article 19, § 31, no money shall be drawn from the treasury except in pursuance of specific appropriation made by law, the purpose of which shall be distinctly stated in the bill, and the maximum amount which may be drawn shall be specified in dollars and cents; and no appropriations made by the General Assembly after December 31, 2008 2020, shall be for a longer period than one (1) fiscal year two (2) years.

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10 SECTION 4. Arkansas Constitution, Article 5, § 34, is amended to read 11 as follows:

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§ 34. Introduction of bills - Time limit.

13 No new bill shall be introduced into either house during the last three 14 days of a regular or fiscal session.

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16 SECTION 5. Arkansas Constitution, Article 5, § 39, is amended to read 17 as follows:

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[§ 39.] State expenses - Limitation - Exceptions.

19 § 3. Excepting monies raised or collected for educational purposes, 20 highway purposes, to pay Confederate pensions and the just debts of the 21 State, the General Assembly is hereby prohibited from appropriating or 22 expending more than the sum of Two and One-Half Million Dollars for all 23 purposes, for any fiscal year biennial period; provided the limit herein 24 fixed may be exceeded by the votes of three-fourths of the members elected to 25 each House of the General Assembly.

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27 SECTION 6. Arkansas Constitution, Article 5, § 40, is amended to read 28 as follows:

[§ 40.] General appropriation bill - Enactment.

30 § 4. In making appropriations for any fiscal year biennial period, the 31 General Assembly shall first pass the General Appropriation Bill provided for 32 in Section 30 of Article 5 of the Constitution, and no other appropriation 33 bill may be enacted before that shall have been done.

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35 SECTION 7. Arkansas Constitution, Article 5, § 42(b), concerning the 36 review and approval of administrative rules by a legislative committee, is

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amended to read as follows:

(b) The review and approval by a legislative committee under
subsection (a) of this section may occur during the interim or during a
regular, or special, or fiscal session of the General Assembly.

6 SECTION 8. Arkansas Constitution, Amendment 35, § 7, is amended to 7 read as follows:

8 § 7. Executive secretary and other personnel - Selection - Salaries
9 and expenditures.

10 The Commission shall elect an Executive Secretary, whose salary shall 11 not exceed that of limitations placed on other constitutional departments; 12 and other executive officers, supervisor, personnel, office assistants, 13 wardens, game refuge keepers, and hatchery employees, whose salaries and 14 expenditures must be submitted to the Legislature and approved by an Act 15 covering specific items in the <u>biennial</u> appropriation as covered by Article 16 XVI Section 4 of the Constitution.

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18 SECTION 9. Nothing in this amendment shall be construed to alter the 19 Governor's authority to call a special session of the General Assembly.

21 SECTION 10. EFFECTIVE DATE. <u>This amendment is effective on and after</u> 22 January 1, 2021.

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SECTION 11. BALLOT TITLE AND POPULAR NAME. <u>When this proposed</u>
