29 SECTION 27. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

30 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. DHE -

31 EMERGENCY GRANTS & EXTRA HELP POOL. An Institution of higher education that

32 suffers an emergency/disaster event resulting in all or a significant portion

33 of campus operations being interrupted, may request disaster assistance

34 through the Arkansas Department of Education - Division of Higher

35 Education. Upon the declaration of an emergency by the Governor, the

36 institution may request, subject to the recommendation of the Director of the

10 SECTION 45. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
11 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. DHE -  
12 ADMINISTRATIVE FEES. The Department of Higher Education is authorized to  
13 recover non-refundable administrative fees related to the institutional  
14 certification and exemption process for out-of-state, non-public, and for-  
15 profit colleges and universities. These fees include a notification fee, an  
16 application processing fee, and travel expenses for the certification review  
17 teams.

18 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2019~~  
19 2020 through June 30, ~~2020~~ 2021.

21 SECTION 46. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
22 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. DHE  
23 WORKFORCE INITIATIVE ACT FUNDING. The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State may  
24 transfer, on his or her books and those of the State Treasurer and the  
25 Auditor of the State, funding up to the amount authorized in the Workforce  
26 Initiative Act of 2015 appropriation section in this Act, from the Division  
27 of Higher Education Fund Account to the Workforce Initiative Act of 2015 Fund  
28 in order to finance the distribution of grants identified under §6-60-107.

34 ARKANSAS WORKS AND ARKANSAS HEALTH INSURANCE MARKETPLACE RESTRICTIONS. (a)  
35 As used in this section, "Arkansas Works Program" means the Arkansas Works  
36 Program established under the Identical Acts 2016 (2nd Ex. Sess.), Nos. 1 and

1 2, Arkansas Code § 23-61-1001 et seq.

2 (b)(1) Determining the maximum number of employees, the maximum amount  
3 of appropriation, for what purposes an appropriation is authorized, and  
4 general revenue funding for a publicly supported institution of higher  
5 education each fiscal year is the prerogative of the General Assembly.

6 (2) The purposes of subdivision (b)(1) of this section are  
7 typically accomplished by:

8 (A) Identifying the purpose in the appropriation act;

9 (B) Delineating such maximums in the appropriation act for  
10 a publicly supported institution of higher education; and

11 (C) Delineating the general revenue allocations authorized  
12 for each fund and fund account by amendment to the Revenue Stabilization Law,  
13 Arkansas Code § 19-5-101 et seq.

14 (3) It is both necessary and appropriate that the General  
15 Assembly restrict the use of appropriations authorized in the acts of  
16 publicly supported institutions of higher education.

17 (c)(1) Except as provided in this subsection, the publicly supported  
18 institutions of higher education shall not allocate, budget, expend, or  
19 utilize any appropriation authorized by the General Assembly for the purpose  
20 of advertisement, promotion, or other activities designed to promote or  
21 encourage enrollment in the Arkansas Health Insurance Marketplace or the  
22 Arkansas Works Program, including without limitation:

23 (A) Unsolicited communications mailed to potential

6 (D) Using an Internet website for the exclusive purpose of

9 (d) The publicly supported institutions of higher education shall not  
10 apply for or accept any funds, including without limitation federal funds,  
11 for the purpose of advertisement, promotion, or other activities designed to  
12 promote or encourage enrollment in the Arkansas Health Insurance Marketplace  
13 or the Arkansas Works Program.

14 (e)(1) Except as provided in subdivision (e)(2) of this section, the  
15 publicly supported institutions of higher education shall not:

16 (A)(i) Except as provided in subdivision (e)(1)(A)(ii) of  
17 this section, allocate, budget, expend, or utilize an appropriation  
18 authorized by the General Assembly for the purpose of funding activities of  
19 navigators, guides, certified application counselors, and certified licensed  
20 producers under the Arkansas Health Insurance Marketplace Navigator, Guide,  
21 and Certified Application Counselors Act, Arkansas Code § 23-64-601 et seq.

22 (ii) Subdivision (e)(1)(A)(i) of this section does  
23 not apply to regulatory and training responsibilities related to navigators,  
24 guides, certified application counselors, and certified licensed producers;

26 (B) Apply for or accept any funds, including without  
27 limitation federal funds, for the purpose of funding activities of  
28 navigators, guides, certified application counselors, and certified licensed  
29 producers under the Arkansas Health Insurance Marketplace Navigator, Guide,  
30 and Certified Application Counselors Act, Arkansas Code § 23-64-601 et seq.

31 (2) Subdivision (e)(1) of this section does not apply to

15 amount necessary to fund scholarship awards for nontraditional students for  
16 the 2017-2018 academic year that were not funded due to the limitation on the  
17 scholarship award amount for nontraditional students under § 6-85-  
18 212(e)(2)(A) as it existed before the effective date of this act.

19 (B) The department may distribute scholarship awards to  
20 nontraditional students for the 2017-2018 academic year from funds  
21 transferred under subdivision (1)(A) of this section; and

22 (2)(A) The Office of the Arkansas Lottery in an amount not to  
23 exceed the amount required to fund scholarship awards to be distributed under  
24 § 6-85-201 et seq. for the 2018-2019 or 2019-2020 academic years without

2 STATEWIDE SCHOLARSHIP AND GRANT PROMOTION. Of the general revenue that is  
3 received by and distributed from the Higher Education Grants Fund Account,  
4 the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall transfer two hundred ninety-five  
5 thousand dollars (\$295,000) to the Division of Higher Education Fund Account  
6 to be allocated, budgeted, committed and distributed to the Statewide  
7 Scholarship and Grant Promotion line item in the General Operations section  
8 of this Act for the purpose of increasing public awareness of the  
9 scholarships and grants offered by the State through the Arkansas Department

19 ADDITIONAL TEACHING LOAD. Full-time staff and ten (10) extra help positions  
20 at Northwest Technical Institute, may be paid up the seventy-five dollars  
21 (\$75) per clock hour for the fiscal year ending June 30, ~~2020~~ 2021, for  
22 noncredit teaching assignments; or up to five hundred fifty dollars (\$550)  
23 per semester hour for the fiscal year ending June 30, ~~2020~~ 2021, for teaching  
24 courses beyond the defined teaching load; and the employee's maximum  
25 allowable salary may be exceeded by such amount; provided, however, that such

33 SECTION 51. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds

1 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
2 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal  
3 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
4 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
5 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

7 SECTION 52. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
8 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
9 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for  
10 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
11 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
12 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
13 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
14 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

15  
16 SECTION 53. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the  
17 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits  
18 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the  
19 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2020 is essential to the operation of  
20 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
21 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the  
22 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2020 could work irreparable harm  
23 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental  
24 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act  
25 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health  
26 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2020.
