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22	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 17-80-402(4), concerning	the definition of

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21	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 17-80-403(c), concerning the establishment
22	of a professional relationship, is amended to read as follows:
23	(c) "Professional relationship" does not include a relationship
24	between a healthcare professional and a patient established only by the
25	following:
26	(1) An internet questionnaire;
27	(2) An email message;
28	(3) Patient-generated medical history;
29	(4) Audio-only communication, including without limitation
30	interactive audio;
31	(5) Text messaging;
32	(6)(5) A facsimile machine; or
33	(7)(6) Any combination thereof of means listed in subdivisions
34	(c)(1)-(5) of this section.
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1	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code \S 23-79-1601(2)(C), concerning the definition
2	of "health benefit plan", is amended to read as follows:
3	(C) "Health benefit plan" does not include:
4	(i) Disability income plans;
5	(ii) Credit insurance plans;
6	(iii) Insurance coverage issued as a supplement to
7	liability insurance;
8	(iv) Medical payments under automobile or homeowners
9	insurance plans;
10	(v) Health benefit plans provided under Arkansas
11	Constitution, Article 5, § 32, the Workers' Compensation Law, § 11-9-101 et
12	seq., or the Public Employee Workers' Compensation Act, § 21-5-601 et seq.;
13	(vi) Plans that provide only indemnity for hospital
14	confinement;
15	(vii) Accident-only plans;
16	(viii) Specified disease plans; or
17	(ix) Long-term-care-only plans; or
18	(x) Stand-alone dental or vision benefit plans;
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20	SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 23-79-1601(7), concerning the definition of
21	"telemedicine", is amended to read as follows:
22	(7)(A) "Telemedicine" means the use of electronic information
23	and communication technology to deliver healthcare services, including
24	without limitation the assessment, diagnosis, consultation, treatment,
25	education, care management, and self-management of a patient.
26	(B) "Telemedicine" includes store-and-forward technology
27	and remote patient monitoring.
28	(C) For the purposes of this subchapter, "telemedicine"
29	does not include the use of:
30	(i) Audio-only communication, including without
31	limitation interactive audio unless the audio-only communication is real-
32	time, interactive, and substantially meets the requirements for a healthcare
33	service that would otherwise be covered by the health benefit plan;
34	(ii) A facsimile machine;
35	(iii) Text messaging; or
36	(iv) Electronic mail systems <u>Email</u> .

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2	SECTION 5. Arkansas Code § 23-79-1602(e), concerning prohibitions on
3	the coverage for telemedicine services, is amended to read as follows:
4	(e) A health benefit plan shall not impose on coverage for healthcare
5	services provided through telemedicine:
6	(1) An annual or lifetime dollar maximum on coverage for
7	services provided through telemedicine other than an annual or lifetime
8	dollar maximum that applies to the aggregate of all items and services
9	covered;
10	(2) A deductible, copayment, coinsurance, benefit limitation, or
11	maximum benefit that is not equally imposed upon all healthcare services
12	covered under the health benefit plan; or
13	(3) A prior authorization requirement for services provided
14	through telemedicine that exceeds the prior authorization requirement for in-
15	person healthcare services under the health benefit plan; or
16	(4) A requirement or financial incentive of any kind for a
17	covered person to choose any commercial telemedicine service provider or a
18	restricted network of telemedicine-only providers rather than the covered
19	person's regular doctor or provider of choice.
