3	(b) The Arkansas Medicaid Program shall reimburse for the following		
4	behavioral and mental health services provided via telemedicine:		
5	(1) Behavioral health wellness-check services;		
6	(2) Counseling and psychoeducation provided by a person licensed		
7	<u>as:</u>		
8	(A) A psychologist;		
9	(B) A psychological examiner;		
10	(C) A professional counselor;		
11	(D) An associate counselor;		
12	(E) An associate marriage and family therapist;		
13	(F) A marriage and family therapist;		
14	(G) A clinical social worker; or		
15	(H) A master social worker;		
16	(3) Crisis intervention services;		
17	(4) Substance abuse assessments;		
18	(5) Mental health diagnosis assessments for an individual under		
19	twenty-one (21) years of age;		
20	(6)(A) Supplemental support services.		
21	(B) The Arkansas Medicaid Program shall also reimburse for		
22	supplemental support services that are provided via telephone or other		
23	telephonic means; and		
24	(7) Group therapy when medically necessary.		
25	(c) The department shall apply for any federal waiver, Medicaid state		
26	plan amendment, or other authorization necessary to implement this section.		
27	(d) This section applies to Medicaid beneficiaries in the fee-for-		
28	service Arkansas Medicaid Program and the managed care Arkansas Medicaid		
29	Program.		
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
