Payments made under this Section shall not be construed as 3 exceeding the maximum annual salary of the employee. 4 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2020 5 2021 through June 30, 2021 2022. 6 7 SECTION 16. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE 8 ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 9 PERMANENT GIFT SHOP. The Arkansas Secretary of State shall operate a gift shop to be permanently located in a space on the first floor of the State 10 11 Capitol Building. It shall be the duty of the Secretary of State to maintain 12 a space on the first floor of the State Capitol Building for the use of a gift shop. The Arkansas Secretary of State is prohibited from removing a 13 14 gift shop from the first floor of the State Capitol Building or to nullify or void the provisions of this section. A space on the first floor of the State 15 Capitol Building shall be the only location for the Arkansas Secretary of 16 17 State gift shop operations and shall be the only location items of the Arkansas Secretary of State gift shop are sold to the public. 18 19 20 SECTION 17. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 21 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 22 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 23 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 24 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 25 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 26 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 27 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 28 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds. 29 30 SECTION 18. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 31 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 32 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 33 34 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 35 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or

summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative

1	Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
2	
3	SECTION 19. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
4	General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
5	the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
6	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2021 is essential to the operation of
7	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided; with the
8	exception that Section 13 in this Act shall be in full force and effect from
9	and after the date of its passage and approval; and that in the event of an
10	extension of the Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond
11	July 1, 2021, with the exception that Section 13 in this Act shall be in full
12	force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval, could
13	work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of
14	essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared
15	to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the
16	public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and
17	after July 1, 2021; with the exception that Section 13 in this Act shall be
18	in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.
