4 SECTION 27. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 5 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 6 PROMOTIONAL AND EDUCATIONAL MATERIALS. 36 accounts on his or her books and on the books of the Treasurer of State and

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the Auditor of State for the payment of personal services and operating

(B) Upon prior approval of the Arkansas Legislative Council, or
if meeting in Legislative Session the Joint Budget Committee, the Chief
Fiscal Officer of the State shall direct the transfer of funds and

this act and the transfer of positions to the Regular Salaries - Shared
Services appropriation section of this act on the books of the Treasurer of

(A) The position number, authorized position title, class

11 (d) Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount 12 of appropriation and general revenue funding for a cabinet-level department 13 each fiscal year is the prerogative of the General Assembly and is usually 14 accomplished by delineating the maximums in the appropriation act or acts and 15 establishing authorized positions and the general revenue allocations 16 authorized for each fund and fund account by amendment to the Revenue 17 Stabilization Law. Further, the General Assembly has determined that the 18 cabinet-level departments created under Acts 2019, No. 910, may operate more 19 efficiently if some flexibility is provided as authorized under this section. 20 Therefore, it is both necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly 21 maintain oversight by requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or, 22 if the General Assembly is in session, the Joint Budget Committee, as 23 provided by this section. The requirement of approval by the Legislative 24 Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this section. 25 If the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget 26 Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, 27 this entire section is void.

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(e) The provisions of this section shall be in effect from the date of 29 passage through June 30, 2021 2022.

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SECTION 30. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 31 32 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 33 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 34 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 35 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 36 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal

1 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 2 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 3 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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SECTION 31. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 5 6 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 7 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 8 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 9 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 10 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 11 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 12 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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14 SECTION 32. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the 15 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits 16 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the 17 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2021 is essential to the operation of 18 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 19 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the 20 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2021 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental 21 22 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act 23 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health 24 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2021. 25 26 */s/Joint Budget Committee* 27 28 29
