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- (c)(1) It is the intent of the Ninety-Second General Assembly that the authority under this section to transfer positions is intended for use for the time period prior to Fiscal Year 2022 2023 to allow cabinet-level departments to establish a centralized Regular Salaries Shared Services section, with the recommendation that the position transfer authority granted under this section be discontinued after that time.
- (2) The Bureau of Legislative Research shall bring the recommendation in subdivision (c)(1) of this section to the attention of the chairs conducting the 2021 2022 Regular Fiscal Session pre-session budget hearings, the chairs of the Special Language Subcommittee, and the members of the Special Language Subcommittee during pre-session budget hearings.
- 12 (d) Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of appropriation and general revenue funding for a cabinet-level department 13 14 each fiscal year is the prerogative of the General Assembly and is usually 15 accomplished by delineating the maximums in the appropriation act or acts and 16 establishing authorized positions and the general revenue allocations 17 authorized for each fund and fund account by amendment to the Revenue 18 Stabilization Law. Further, the General Assembly has determined that the 19 cabinet-level departments created under Acts 2019, No. 910, may operate more 20 efficiently if some flexibility is provided as authorized under this section. 21 Therefore, it is both necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly 22 maintain oversight by requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or, 23 if the General Assembly is in session, the Joint Budget Committee, as 24 provided by this section. The requirement of approval by the Legislative 25 Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this section. 26 If the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget 27 Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, 28 this entire section is void.
  - (e) The provisions of this section shall be in effect from the date of passage through June 30,  $\frac{2021}{2022}$ .

SECTION 30. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. ARKANSAS CULTURAL INSTITUTIONS FUND TRANSFER. From time to time, the Secretary of the Department of Parks, Heritage, and Tourism may instruct the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State to transfer on his or her books, and those of the State

- 1 Treasurer and the Auditor of the State, such amounts as determined by the
- 2 Secretary from the Arkansas Division of Heritage Special Fund Account to a
- 3 <u>sub-fund within the Arkansas Cultural Institutions Trust Fund to make grants</u>
- 4 for major capital improvement projects at Arkansas cultural institutions. For
- 5 any unobligated balances identified by the department, the Secretary may
- 6 <u>instruct the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State to transfer on his or her</u>
- 7 books, and those of the State Treasurer and the Auditor of the State, the
- 8 unobligated sub-fund balances in the Arkansas Cultural Institutions Trust
- 9 Fund to the Arkansas Division of Heritage Special Fund Account.
- The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,
- 11 2021 through June 30, 2022.

- 13 SECTION 31. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

- 15 RIVER COMMISSION. The Department of Parks, Heritage, and Tourism Division
- 16 of Heritage shall budget, allocate, and expend twenty thousand dollars
- 17 (\$20,000) in grants to the Ouachita River Commission from the Grants/Aid-
- 18 <u>Ouachita River Commission line item in the Conservation Tax Amendment 75</u>
- 19 appropriation section, to be used exclusively as determined by the Ouachita
- 20 River Commission.
- 21 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,
- 22 2021 through June 30, 2022.

- 24 SECTION 32. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
- 25 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
- 26 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
- 27 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
- 28 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary

| 7        | SECTION 34. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the               |
