12	polling places be open on election day so that the election can be conducted
13	by:
14	(i) Absentee ballot and early voting only; or
15	(ii) Election by candidate under the procedure in §
16	7-11-107(b).
17	(B) If a county uses electronic voting machines or
18	electronic vote tabulating devices, and is holding an election under
19	subdivision (c)(1) of this section, the county board of election
20	commissioners may use:
21	$\frac{(i)(A)}{(A)}$ The electronic voting machines or electronic
22	vote tabulating devices; or
23	(ii)(B) Paper ballots counted by hand and provide no
24	voting machines to be used in the election, notwithstanding any other
25	provision in the Arkansas Code.

27	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 6-14-111(k), concerning candidate filing
28	procedures for school elections, is amended to read as follows:
29	(k) The order in which the names of the respective candidates are to
30	appear on the ballot shall be determined by lot at the public meeting of the
31	county board of election commissioners held not later than:
32	(1) seventy-two Seventy-two (72) days before the annual school
33	election, if the election is to be held on the first Tuesday following the
34	first Monday in November or on the third Tuesday in May; or
35	(2) Eighty-nine (89) days before the annual school election if
36	the election is to be held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in

1	March for years in which the office of President of the United States will	
2	appear on the ballot at the general election.	
3		
4	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 7-5-202(a)(1), concerning public notice of	
5	elections, is amended to read as follows:	
6	(a)(1) It shall be the duty of the county board of election	
7	commissioners at least twenty (20) days <u>eight (8) days</u> before each <u>the</u>	
8	beginning of early voting for a preferential primary, general primary, and	
9	general election and at least ten (10) days before the holding of each	
10	general primary, general runoff, school, or special election to give public	
11	notice in a newspaper of general circulation in the county of:	
12	(A) The date of the election;	
13	(B) The hours of voting on election day;	
14	(C) The places and times for early voting;	
15	(D) Polling sites for holding the elections in the county;	
16	(E) The candidates and offices to be elected at that time;	
17	(F) The time and location of the opening, processing,	
18	canvassing, and counting of ballots; and	
19	(G) The location where $\frac{a-list}{lists}$ of appointed election	
20	officials, deputy county clerks, or additional deputies hired to conduct	
21	early voting can be found and the date dates the list is lists are available;	
22	<u>and</u>	
23	(H) Directions for filing a written objection to the	
24	service of an election official, deputy county clerk, or additional deputy.	
25		
26	SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 7-5-202(a)(2)(B), concerning public notice	
27	of elections, is amended to read as follows:	
28	(B) Another person makes an objection to his or her	
29	service to the county board of election commissioners within $\frac{10}{10}$ seven	
30	(7) calendar days after posting the list of officials.	
31		
32	SECTION 5. Arkansas Code § 7-5-202(a)(3), concerning public notice of	
33	elections, is repealed.	
34	(3) The public notice shall contain directions for filing an	
35	objection to the service of an election official, deputy county clerk, or	
36	additional deputy.

2	SECTION 6. Arkansas Code § 7-5-202(b), concerning public notice of
3	elections, is amended to read as follows:
4	(b)(l) At least five (5) days prior to before a preferential primary,
5	general primary, general election, general runoff, school election, or
6	special election, a copy of the public notice may be posted at each polling
7	site fixed for holding the election and shall be published in a newspaper of
8	general circulation in the county.
9	(2)(A) $\underline{\text{(i)}}$ At least fifteen (15) eight (8) days before the
10	beginning of early voting and the election day, each county board of election
11	commissioners or county clerk shall prepare and post in a public place in the
12	county clerk's office its list of appointed election officials, deputy county
13	clerks, or additional deputies hired to conduct early voting.
14	(B)(ii) The list may appoint contain the names of
15	appointed election officials, deputy county clerks, or additional deputies
16	hired to conduct early voting in the event of a runoff election.
17	(B)(i) At least eight (8) days before election day, each
18	county board of election commissioners shall prepare and post in a public
19	place in the county clerk's office its list of appointed election officials
20	for election day.
21	(ii) The list may appoint election officials hired
22	for election day in the event of a runoff election.
23	
24	SECTION 7. Arkansas Code § 7-5-207(a)(2)(B)(iii)-(v), concerning the
25	names included on ballots and drawing for ballot position, are amended to
26	read as follows:
27	(iii) Votes received by an unopposed candidate for
28	the office of Governor, Mayor, Circuit Clerk, City Clerk, mayor, circuit
29	clerk, or the office of a nonjudicial state elected official shall be counted
30	or tabulated by the election officials and certified according to law.
31	(iv) The names of all unopposed candidates for the
32	office of Mayor, Governor, Gircuit Clerk, City Clerk, mayor, circuit clerk,
33	and the office of a nonjudicial state elected official shall be separately
34	placed on the general election ballot, and the votes for Mayor, Governor,
35	Circuit Clerk, City Clerk, and a nonjudicial state elected official shall be

tabulated as in all contested races.

1	(v) All unopposed candidates, other than for the
2	offices of Mayor, Governor, Circuit Clerk, City Clerk, mayor, circuit clerk,
3	and the office of a nonjudicial state elected official, shall be declared and
4	certified as elected in the same manner as if the candidate had been voted
5	upon at the election.
6	
7	SECTION 8. Arkansas Code § 7-5-701(a)(2), concerning declaration,
8	certification, delivery and custody of election returns, is amended to read
9	as follows:
10	(2) Unopposed candidates, other than candidates for mayor,
11	governor, city clerk, and circuit clerk, shall be separately declared and
12	certified to the Secretary of State as elected in the same manner as if the
13	candidate had been voted upon at the election.
14	
15	SECTION 9. Arkansas Code § 14-42-206(a)(3), concerning nominating
16	petitions for municipal elections, is amended to read as follows:
17	(3) When the resolution has been adopted, the clerk or recorder
18	shall mail a certified copy of the resolution to the chairs of the county
19	party committees, the county clerk, and to the chairs of the state party
20	committees.
21	
22	SECTION 10. Arkansas Code § 14-42-206(d)(2)(b), concerning nominating
23	petitions for municipal elections, is amended to read as follows:
24	(B) The ordinance shall be published at least one (1) time
25	a week for two (2) consecutive weeks immediately following adoption of the
26	ordinance in a newspaper having a general circulation in the city, and shall
27	be filed with the county clerk.
28	
29	SECTION 11. Arkansas Code § 26-75-207(b)(2), concerning levying of a
30	sales and use tax for capital improvements in a municipality, is amended to
31	read as follows:
32	(2) The petition shall be signed by a number of the legal voters
33	in the city that is no less than fifteen percent (15%) of the number of votes
34	cast for the office of $\frac{\text{city clerk}}{\text{clerk}}$ $\frac{\text{mayor}}{\text{at}}$ at the last preceding general
35	election.
