## For An Act To Be Entitled

9 AN ACT REQUIRING A CORRECTIONAL OR DETENTION FACILITY  
10 OPERATED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS TO  
11 ESTABLISH A POLICY TO OFFER MAMMOGRAMS AND PHYSICIAN  
12 CONSULTATIONS TO FEMALE INMATES AND DETAINEES OF

## Subtitle

16 REQUIRING A CORRECTIONAL OR DETENTION

25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
26

27 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 12, Chapter 32, is amended to add an  
28 additional section to read as follows:

29 12-32-104. Mammograms and physician consultation.

30 (a) A correctional or detention facility operated or administered by  
31 the Department of Corrections shall establish a policy to offer a female  
32 inmate or detainee who is:

33 (1) Fifty (50) years of age or older but younger than seventy-  
34 five (75) years of age a mammogram screening every two (2) years; and

35 (2) Forty (40) years of age or older but younger than fifty (50)  
36 years of age a consultation with a physician to seek professional care as to



1 when to receive a mammogram.

2 (b) A mammogram or consultation with a physician shall be at no cost  
3 to the female inmate or detainee.
