- § 32. <u>Compensation for injuries to persons and property Workmen's</u>
 Worker's Compensation Laws Actions for personal injuries.
- 16 (a) The sanctity of life being paramount to all other rights
 17 recognized by this Constitution and the laws of the State of Arkansas, it is
 18 declared and established that the citizens of this state, acting as jurors,
 19 have the sole authority to determine the amount of compensation owed for, or

- 21 (1) Injuries resulting in death; or
- 22 (2) Injuries resulting from acts or omissions creating a 23 significant risk to life.
