11	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the	
12	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that possession of photographs	
13	described in this act by an inmate in the Department of Corrections	
14	compromises the security of the correctional facility in which the inmate is	
15	housed. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and this act being	
16	immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and	
17	safety shall become effective on:	
18	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;	
19	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,	
20	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the	
21	bill; or	
22	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is	
23	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
