21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
22

23 SECTION 1. DO NOT CODIFY. The purpose of this act is to clarify that
24 the "catalyst theory" applies to attorney's fees and other litigation
25 expenses under the Freedom of Information Act of 1967, § 25-19-101 et seq.,
26 to the extent that that attorney's fees and other litigation expenses
27 incurred under the act shall be awarded to a plaintiff if the defendant
28 public entity provides a significant or material portion of the contested
29 public information during the course of litigation, but prior to an order of
30 the court.

32 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 25-19-107(d)(1), concerning the right to
33 appeal a denial of rights under the Freedom of Information Act of 1967 and
34 the awarding of attorney's fees, is amended to read as follows:

35 (d)(1) In any action to enforce the rights granted by this chapter, or
36 in any appeal therefrom, the court shall assess against the defendant



1 reasonable attorney's fees and other litigation expenses reasonably incurred
2 by a plaintiff who ~~has substantially prevailed~~, after filing suit, has
3 obtained from the defendant a significant or material portion of the public
4 information he or she requested, unless the court finds that the position of
5 the defendant was substantially justified by clearly established law.
