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1 SECTION 2. REAPPROPRIATION - BOND PROCEEDS. There is hereby 2 appropriated, to the Arkansas Agriculture Department, to be payable from the 3 Bond Proceeds, for the Arkansas Agriculture Department the following: (A) Effective July 1, 2021, the balance of the appropriation provided 4 5 in Item (A) of Section 2 of Act 109 of 2020, for construction of New Office 6 Space, Laboratories and Support Facilities for the Department of Agriculture, 7 in a sum not to exceed\$60,000,000. 8 (B) Effective July 1, 2021, the balance of the appropriation provided 9 in Item (B) of Section 2 of Act 109 of 2020, for construction, renovation, 10 repairs and equipping of new office space, laboratories, and support 11 facilities for the Department of Agriculture, in a sum not to exceed 12\$60,000,000. 13 14 SECTION 3. REAPPROPRIATION - NECROPSY ROOM IMPROVEMENTS. There is 15 hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas Agriculture Department, to be payable 16 from the Livestock and Poultry Special Revenue Fund, for the Arkansas 17 Agriculture Department the following: 18 (A) Effective July 1, 2021, the balance of the appropriation provided 19 in Item (A) of Section 3 of Act 109 of 2020, for construction, renovation and 20 equipping of the Necropsy Room at the Livestock and Poultry Diagnostic Lab, 21 in a sum not to exceed\$69,563. 22 23 SECTION 4. REAPPROPRIATION - NATURAL AND CULTURAL RESOURCES COUNCIL -24 STATE OWNED LANDS OR HISTORIC SITES. There is hereby appropriated, to the 25 Arkansas Agriculture Department, to be payable from the Arkansas Natural and 26 Cultural Resources Grant and Trust Fund, for the Arkansas Agriculture 27 Department the following: (A) Effective July 1, 2021, the balance of the appropriation provided 28 29 in Item (A) of Section 27 of Act 18 of 2020, for acquisition, management, stewardship or preservation of state owned lands, historic sites, buildings, 30 31 structures or objects, in a sum not to exceed\$1,606,459. 32 33 SECTION 5. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor 34 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects

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therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and

described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available

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1 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and 2 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or 3 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State 4 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects 5 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds 6 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General 7 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall 8 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

9 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State 10 Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the 11 Revenue Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of 12 this State and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and 13 Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in 14 disbursement of any funds provided by this act unless specifically provided 15 otherwise by law.

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17 SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 18 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 19 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 20 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 21 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 22 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 23 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 24 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 25

26 SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 27 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the 28 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2021 is essential to the operation of 29 30 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the 31 32 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2021 could work irreparable harm 33 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental 34 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health 35 36 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2021.

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
