4	to the Arkansas Local Police and Fire	Retirement System, to be payable from

24	SECTION 3. SPECIAL LANGUAGE.	NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS				
25	CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPEC	IAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUNDING				
26	TRANSFER - FIRE AND POLICE PENSION. On or before June 15 of each fiscal year,					
27	the Arkansas Fire and Police Pension Review Board shall certify to the Chief					
28	Fiscal Officer of the State the amount of funding it recommends for					
29	disbursement in the ensuing fiscal year to under-funded municipal fire and					
30	police relief and pension plans as defined in Arkansas Code 24-11-217. The					
31	Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall then immediately transfer on his					
32	books and those of the State Treasurer amounts not to exceed the total amount					
33	recommended by the Board or the amount appropriated herein for the ensuing					
34	fiscal year, whichever is the lesser amount, from the Revenue Holding Fund					
35	Account to the Arkansas Fire and Police Pension Guarantee Fund for					
36	distribution to the recommended under-funded plans					

1	The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,
2	2021 through June 30, 2022.
3	
4	SECTION 4. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
5	CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND
6	RESTRICTIONS - FIRE AND POLICE PENSION. Funds distributed to under-funded
7	local pension programs through the Pension and Relief Funds appropriation
8	authorized in the Operations Section of this Act shall not be used to enhance
9	benefits of the recipients.
10	The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,
11	2021 through June 30, 2022.
12	
13	SECTION 5. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
14	authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
15	and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
16	the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
17	Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
18	Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
19	control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
20	the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
21	strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.
22	
23	SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
24	Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
25	contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
26	which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
27	Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
28	manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
29	summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
30	Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
31	
32	SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
33	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
34	appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
35	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2021 is essential to the operation of
36	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in

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     the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
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     effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2021 could work irreparable harm
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     upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
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     programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
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     being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
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     and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2021.
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
