## Subtitle

19 TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING  
20 ELECTIONEERING; AND TO AMEND THE LAW

26 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
27

28 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 7-1-103(a), concerning definitions,  
29 penalties, and miscellaneous misdemeanor offenses relating to elections, is  
30 amended to add an additional subdivision to read as follows:

31 (23) A person shall not enter or remain in an area within one  
32 hundred feet (100') of the primary exterior entrance to a building where  
33 voting is taking place except for a person entering or leaving a building  
34 where voting is taking place for lawful purposes.
