- 4 (PASSE). Non-profit community-based programs licensed by the Division of
- 5 Developmental Disabilities Services are quasi-governmental instrumentalities
- 6 of the state which provide supports and services to individuals who have a
- 7 developmental disability or delay, who would otherwise require supports and
- 8 services through state-operated programs and facilities owned by the State of
- 9 Arkansas. When licensed providers are involved in delivering services which
- 10 are Medicaid reimbursable, they must enroll as a provider with the Arkansas
- 11 Medicaid Program and must bill the Arkansas Medicaid Program for all covered
- 12 services for eligible individuals.
- 13 Services which are covered by the Arkansas State Medicaid Program,
- 14 including the Provider-Led Arkansas Shared Savings Entity (PASSE) model, will
- 15 be utilized to the maximum extent possible for any individual who is eligible
- 16 for Medicaid coverage. It is the intent of this section that DDS, as a
- 17 general policy, maximize the use of Medicaid funding available for
- 18 appropriate services.
- 19 Licensed private community providers funded from these appropriations for

- 18 DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES TIMBER SALES PROCEEDS CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS AND
- 19 EQUIPMENT. The Division of Developmental Disabilities Services is authorized
- 20 to use the administrative operating accounts for capital improvements to
- 21 physical plants and for the purchase of capital equipment. The funds shall be
- 22 held by the Department of Human Services Division of Developmental
- 23 Disabilities Services from the proceeds of the sale of timber that may be
- 24 harvested from land owned by the Division of Developmental Disabilities
- 25 Services. All funds deposited and all expenses shall be tracked separately.
- 26 The harvesting of timber is specifically authorized to provide funds to
- 27 finance capital improvements to the physical plants and for the purchase of
- 28 major capital equipment.
- 29 The Division of Developmental Disabilities Services shall report all
- 30 income derived from timber management to the Chief Fiscal Officer of the
- 31 State and the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee. Any
- 32 contracts initiated for the harvesting of timber shall be submitted to the
- 33 Review Subcommittee of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget
- 34 Committee for prior review. All expenditures of funds derived from the sale
- 35 of timber will be expended in accordance with relevant state purchasing laws.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2020

effective date of this Act, the Department of Human Services - Division of Developmental Disabilities Services shall budget, allocate, and expend up to one million dollars (\$1,000,000) for the elimination of the Autism Waiver Services Program waiting list.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, $\frac{2020}{100}$ 2021 through June 30, $\frac{2021}{100}$ 2022.

SECTION 16. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

SECTION 18. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2021 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2021 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
