- (h)(1) Members of the board may be removed from the office by the 24
- 25 Governor appropriate appointing authority:
- 26 (A) For good cause pursuant to under § 25-16-804;
- 27 (B) For cause including dishonorable or unprofessional
- conduct, abuse of authority, malfeasance, misfeasance, or nonfeasance; or 28
- 29 (C)(i) For any reason that would justify probation,
- 30 suspension, or revocation of a physician's license to practice medicine under
- 31 the Arkansas Medical Practices Act, § 17-95-201 et seq., § 17-95-301 et seq.,
- 32 and § 17-95-401 et seq., or for any reason that would justify probation,
- 33 suspension, or revocation of a physician assistant's license to practice
- 34 under § 17-105-101 et seq., which shall be referred directly to the Division
- 35 of Pharmacy Services and Drug Control of the Department of Health by the
- 36 Governor appropriate appointing authority for investigation as provided in §
