**SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION**

11 AN AMENDMENT TO THE ARKANSAS CONSTITUTION TO ALLOW  
12 THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY TO CONVENE ITSELF IN  
13 EXTRAORDINARY SESSION UPON THE JOINT PROCLAMATION OF  
14 THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE  
15 PRESIDENT PRO TEMPORE OF THE SENATE.

**Subtitle**

19 AN AMENDMENT TO THE ARKANSAS CONSTITUTION  
20 AUTHORIZING THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY TO  
21 CONVENE ITSELF IN EXTRAORDINARY SESSION.

24 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-THIRD GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE  
25 STATE OF ARKANSAS, AND BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, A MAJORITY OF ALL  
26 MEMBERS ELECTED TO EACH HOUSE AGREEING THERETO:

28 THAT the following is proposed as an amendment to the Constitution of  
29 the State of Arkansas, and upon being submitted to the electors of the state  
30 for approval or rejection at the next general election for Representatives  
31 and Senators, if a majority of the electors voting thereon at the election  
32 adopt the amendment, the amendment shall become a part of the Constitution of  
33 the State of Arkansas, to wit:

35 SECTION 1. Arkansas Constitution, Article 5, § 5, is amended to read  
36 as follows:



1 § 5. Regular and fiscal sessions.

2 (a) The General Assembly shall meet at the seat of government every  
3 year.

4 (b) The General Assembly shall meet in regular session on the second  
5 Monday in January of each odd-numbered year to consider any bill or  
6 resolution. The General Assembly may alter the time at which the regular  
7 session begins.

8 (c)(1) Beginning in 2010, the General Assembly shall meet in fiscal  
9 session on the second Monday in February of each even-numbered year to  
10 consider only appropriation bills. The General Assembly may alter the time at  
11 which the fiscal session begins.

12 (2) A bill other than an appropriation bill may be considered in  
13 a fiscal session if two-thirds (2/3) of the members of each house of the  
14 General Assembly approve consideration of the bill.

15 (d) The General Assembly, by a vote of two-thirds (2/3) of the members  
16 elected to each house of the General Assembly, may alter the dates of the  
17 regular session and fiscal session so that regular sessions occur in even  
18 numbered years and the fiscal sessions occur in odd-numbered years.

19 (e)(1)(A) The General Assembly shall meet in extraordinary session  
20 upon the joint proclamation of the Speaker of the House of Representatives  
21 and the President Pro Tempore of the Senate.

22 (B) The General Assembly may consider any type or subject  
23 matter of legislation at an extraordinary session under subdivision (e)(1) of  
24 this section.

25 (2)(A) During each regular session, the General Assembly shall  
26 establish by joint rule procedures for an extraordinary session under  
27 subdivision (e)(1) of this section.

28 (B) Joint rules established under subdivision (e)(2)(A) of  
29 this section may include without limitation:

30 (i) A limitation on the duration of an extraordinary  
31 session under subdivision (e)(1) of this section; and

32 (ii) A provision permitting the General Assembly, by  
33 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to both houses, to remain in  
34 session for a period not exceeding fifteen (15) days after the conclusion of  
35 an extraordinary session under subdivision (e)(1) of this section.

36 (C) Rules established under subdivision (e)(2)(A) of this

1 section may be amended by the General Assembly.

2 (3) This section does not restrict the authority of the Governor  
3 to convene an extraordinary session of the General Assembly under Arkansas  
4 Constitution, Article 6, § 19.

5  
6 SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This amendment shall be effective on and  
7 after November 9, 2022.

8  
9 SECTION 3. BALLOT TITLE AND POPULAR NAME. When this proposed  
10 amendment is submitted to the electors of this state on the general election  
11 ballot:

12 (1) The title of this Joint Resolution shall be the ballot  
13 title; and

14 (2) The popular name shall be "A Constitutional Amendment to  
15 Allow the General Assembly to Convene Itself in Extraordinary Session Upon  
16 the Joint Proclamation of the Speaker of the House of Representatives and the  
17 President Pro Tempore of the Senate".
