21 WHEREAS, Kayle Browning is an American sport shooter and is also an
22 native Arkansan who has been shooting since she was eight (8) years old and
23 has dreamed her whole life of going to the Olympics; and

25 WHEREAS, beginning her target shooting career in sporting clay
26 shooting, Kayle Browning made the open All-American Team at twelve (12) years
27 old and was an alternate for Team USA at the 2012 Olympic Games; and

29 WHEREAS, Kayle Browning took aim in the 2020 Summer Olympic Games in
30 Tokyo for Team USA where she hit nineteen (19) straight shots after missing
31 three (3) of her first four (4) shots; and

33 WHEREAS, at the end of the qualifying rounds that took place over two
34 (2) days of trap shooting, Kayle Browning earned a silver medal in women's
35 trap shooting, which makes her the first Arkansan and the first American to
36 win a silver medal in women's trap shooting; and
