After seeking and receiving approval of the Governor and Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and upon approval by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, the Director of the Department of Corrections - Division of Community Correction, as authorized by the Board of Corrections, is authorized to use the appropriations authorized under the line item established herein for "Community Correction Programs" are to be used by the Department of Corrections - Division of Community Correction for establishment and operation of, to include construction, renovation, and contracting for establishment and operation of, residential and non-residential community correction programs such as, but not limited to, community correction centers, drug, alcohol, and mental health treatments, intensive supervision, restitution, and others as established and approved by the Board of Corrections and as may be provided by law.

The Department of Corrections - Division 19 of Community Correction shall report quarterly to the Arkansas Legislative 20 Council or Joint Budget Committee the number of vacant Parole/Probation 21 Officer, Parole/Probation Area Manager, Parole/Probation Assistant Area 22 Manager positions and average case load per Parole/Probation Officer. 23 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2021 24 2022 through June 30, 2022 2023.

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SECTION 19. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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SECTION 20. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General

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    Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
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     contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
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    which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
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     Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
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     manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
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     summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
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     Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
