- 30 SECTION 31. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 31 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. OUACHITA
- 32 RIVER COMMISSION. The Department of Parks, Heritage, and Tourism Division
- 33 of Heritage shall budget, allocate, and expend twenty thousand dollars
- 34 (\$20,000) in grants to the Ouachita River Commission from the Grants/Aid-
- 35 Ouachita River Commission line item in the Conservation Tax Amendment 75
- 36 appropriation section, to be used exclusively as determined by the Ouachita

5	SECTION 32. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds

9	Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
