SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 30 31 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER 32 OF FUNDS FOR THE JUVENILE OMBUDSMAN PROGRAM. The Department of Human 33 Services shall provide funding in an amount not to exceed \$240,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022 2023 for the Juvenile Ombudsman Program 34 35 described in ACA 16-87-216. Upon request by the Executive Director of the 36 Arkansas Public Defender Commission, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State

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8 SECTION 9. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 9 TRANSFER 10 OF FUNDS FOR LOCAL JUVENILE DETENTION FACILITIES. The Chief Fiscal Officer 11 of the State shall transfer funds in an amount of \$400,000 for the fiscal 12 year ending June 30, 2022 2023 from the Department of Human Services - Youth 13 Services Fund Account to the Juvenile Detention Facilities Operating Fund to 14 fund the appropriation to the Department of Finance and Administration -15 Disbursing Officer for grants for operating expenses of local juvenile 16 detention facilities.

17 The amount of the funds transferred in the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022 2023 may be adjusted upon request of the Secretary of the Department of 19 Human Services on a pro-rata basis with any reductions provided in the 20 Revenue Stabilization Law from the July 1 Official Forecast of general 21 revenue funding for the Division of Youth Services.

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25 SECTION 10. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 26 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. YOUTH 27 SERVICES - TIMBER SALES PROCEEDS - CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS AND EQUIPMENT. The 28 Division of Youth Services is authorized to use the administrative operating 29 account for capital improvements to the physical plant and for the purchase of capital equipment by the Mansfield Youth Services Facility operated by the 30 31 Department of Human Services, Division of Youth Services. The funds shall be 32 held by the Department of Human Services, Division of Youth Services from the 33 proceeds of the sale of timber that may be harvested from land owned by the 34 Division of Youth Services. All funds deposited and all expenses shall be 35 tracked separately. The harvesting of timber is specifically authorized to 36 provide funds to finance capital improvements to the physical plant and for

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1 the purchase of major capital equipment by the Mansfield Facility from which 2 the timber is sold.

3 The Division of Youth Services shall report all income derived from the 4 sale of timber to the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and the Arkansas 5 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee. Any contracts initiated for 6 the harvesting and sale of timber shall be submitted to the Review 7 Subcommittee of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee 8 for prior review. All expenditures of funds derived from the sale of timber 9 will be expended in accordance with relevant state purchasing laws. 10 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2021 11 2022 through June 30, 2022 2023.

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SECTION 11. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 13 14 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 15 RESIDENTIAL SERVICES CONTINGENCY. If it has been determined that the 16 Department of Human Services - Division of Youth Services cannot continue to 17 contract with private provider(s) for residential juvenile services, 18 educational services, therapeutic services, and/or medical services and deems 19 it necessary to utilize Department staff to provide all or parts of the 20 required services above, the Department is authorized to seek the approval of 21 the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, the Governor and the Arkansas 22 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee to utilize the contingent 23 residential services positions contained in this Act and to make the 24 appropriate transfers from any line item authorized in the RESIDENTIAL 25 SERVICES appropriation of this Act to any line item authorized in the 26 OPERATIONS appropriation of this Act. If it has been determined that the 27 Department of Human Services - Division of Youth Services cannot continue to 28 operate one or more of the various service components of a Residential 29 Facility for residential juvenile services, educational services, therapeutic 30 services, and/or medical services and deems it necessary to utilize a 31 contract with private provider(s), the Department is authorized to seek the 32 approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, the Governor and the 33 Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee to make the 34 appropriate transfers from any line item authorized in the OPERATIONS 35 appropriation of this Act to any line item authorized in the RESIDENTIAL 36 SERVICES appropriation of this Act.

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The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,
 2021 2022 through June 30, 2022 2023.

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SECTION 12. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 4 5 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. EXTRA HELP SALARIES - CONTINGENT RESIDENTIAL SERVICES POSITIONS. There is hereby 6 7 established for the Department of Human Services - Division of Youth Services 8 - Contingent Residential Services Positions, the following maximum number of 9 positions whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform 10 Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code § 21-5-201 et seq.), or 11 its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Requests to use positions 12 will be based upon the non-contracted services for residential juvenile 13 services, educational services, therapeutic services, and/or medical 14 services. If at such time a category(s) of services are contracted with 15 private provider(s), identified positions associated with such service(s) 16 shall be returned to the contingency pool. In order to ensure required 17 staffing levels, Extra Help positions authorized herein are specifically 18 exempt from limitation of hours, either by Act or regulation. 19

1 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 2 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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4	SECTION 14. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
5	Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
6	contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
7	which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
8	Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
9	manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
10	summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
11	Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
