- (3) Each Agency, Board, Commission or Institution shall provide a written report to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee containing all information set forth in item (2) above, along with a written statement as to the current status of the project, contract, purpose etc. for which the carry forward was originally requested no later than thirty (30) days prior to the time the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution presents its budget request to the Arkansas Legislative Council/Joint Budget Committee; and
- (4) Thereupon, the Department of Finance and Administration shall include all information obtained in item (3) above in the budget manuals and/or a statement of non-compliance by the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution.

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SECTION 25. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. THE COMMISSIONER OF THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION. It is the intent of the General Assembly that the appropriation for the salary of the Commissioner of the Department of Education shall be the sole and exclusive authority for his or her salary. It is further the intent of the General Assembly that the Commissioner be required to devote all of his or her working time exclusively to the performance of his or her duties as Commissioner of the Department of Education. Therefore, the Commissioner of the Department of Education is

- l hereby prohibited from accepting any additional salary from any other source
- 2 (including state, federal, or private entities or persons) for the
- 3 performance of his or her duties as Commissioner, and is prohibited from

The report shall also include an accounting of the names, titles, and salaries of personnel whose salaries have been adjusted under provisions of Subsections (a) and (b) of this Section.
- (e) If the Department of Education requests continuation of any "Position Pool" position(s) as established herein during the next fiscal year, the position(s) must be requested as a new position(s) in the agency's budget request.
- 20 (f) Determining the number of personnel to be employed by a state agency 21 is the prerogative of the General Assembly and is usually accomplished by 22 delineating the maximum number of personnel by identifying job titles and the 23 maximum grade or salary attached to those titles. The General Assembly has 24 determined that the Arkansas Department of Education could be operated more 25 efficiently if some flexibility is given to that agency. That flexibility is 26 being accomplished by providing a position pool in Subsections (a) and (b) of 27 this Section and since the General Assembly has granted the agency broad 28 powers under the growth pool concept, it is both necessary and appropriate 29 that the General Assembly maintain oversight of the utilization of the 30 position pool by requiring review of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget 31 Committee in the utilization of the position pool.
