22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

24 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 14-95-104(b), concerning purposes of urban
25 service districts, is amended to read as follows:

26 (b) ~~Districts~~ An urban service district may be created for the
27 following purposes, all of which are found to be public purposes within the
28 meaning of Arkansas Constitution, Amendment 65:

29 (1) Emergency services, including ambulance services, civil
30 defense services, fire prevention and protection services, and public safety
31 and security services;

32 (2) Solid waste services, including recycling services, and
33 solid waste collection and disposal services;

34 (3) Parking services and public transportation services;

35 (4) Recreation services, including parks, playgrounds, bicycle
36 paths, and recreation programs; and



1 (5) Neighborhood improvement services, including, ~~but not~~
2 ~~limited to~~ without limitation:

3 (A) Housing maintenance and redevelopment;

4 (B) Neighborhood business district maintenance and
5 redevelopment;

6 (C) Community facilities maintenance and redevelopment;

7 (D) Street ~~lighting and street cleaning~~ and sidewalk
8 maintenance and redevelopment, including without limitation lighting,
9 cleaning, repairing, resurfacing, and access ramp installation; and

10 (E) Weed lot and alley maintenance services; and

11 (F) Drainage system maintenance and redevelopment,
12 including without limitation services provided by storm water management
13 programs.
