20 21	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
22	DE II ENACIED DI THE GENERAL ASSEMBLI OF THE STATE OF ARRANSAS:
23	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 5-14-101, concerning definitions regarding
24	sexual offenses under the Arkansas Criminal Code, is amended to add an
25	additional subdivision to read as follows:
26	(16) "Consent" means a freely given, knowledgeable, and informed
27	agreement by a person who is not physically helpless, mentally defective,
28	mentally incapacitated, or under the legal age to consent.
29	
30	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 5-14-101(3), concerning the definition of
31	"forcible compulsion" regarding sexual offenses, is amended to read as
32	follows:
33	(3) "Forcible compulsion" means physical force or a:
34	(A) Any bodily impact, restraint, confinement, or threat
35	of bodily impact, restraint, or confinement, whether express or implied;
36	(B) Any threat, express or implied, of death or physical

1	injury to or kidnapping of any person <u>; or</u>
2	(C) Any other behavior that results in a sexual act
3	against the will of the person upon whom the sexual act is committed;
4	
5	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 5-14-125(a)(6), concerning sexual assault
6	in the second degree, is amended to read as follows:
7	(6) $\underline{(A)}$ Is a teacher, principal, athletic coach, or counselor in a
8	public or private school in a grade kindergarten through twelve (K-12), in a
9	position of trust or authority, and uses his or her position of trust or
10	authority over the victim to engage in sexual contact with a victim who is:
11	(A)(i) A student enrolled in the public or private school;
12	and
13	$\frac{(B)}{(ii)}$ Less than twenty-one (21) years of age.
14	(B) It is no defense to a prosecution under subdivision
15	(a)(6)(A) of this section that the victim consented to the conduct.
16	
17	SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 5-14-127(a)(2), concerning sexual assault
18	in the fourth degree, is amended to read as follows:
19	(2) $\underline{(A)}$ Engages in sexual contact with another person who is not
20	the actor's spouse, and the actor is employed with the Division of
21	Correction, Division of Community Correction, Department of Human Services,
22	or any city or county jail, and the victim is in the custody of the Division
23	of Correction, Division of Community Correction, Department of Human
24	Services, or a city or county jail.
25	(B) It is no defense to a prosecution under subdivision
26	(a)(2)(A) of this section that the victim consented to the conduct.
27	
28	SECTION 5. Arkansas Code § 5-26-202, concerning the offense of incest,
29	is amended to add an additional subsection to read as follows:
30	(d) It is no defense to a prosecution under this section that the
31	victim consented to the conduct.
