- 1 (a) That the Regular Session of the Ninety-Fourth General Assembly of 2 the State of Arkansas is extended until 12:00 noon, May 1, 2023;
- That under Arkansas Constitution, Article 6, § 15, prior to 3 adjournment of the General Assembly, the Governor is afforded five (5) days after receipt of a bill to sign a bill or veto a bill, therefore from April 7, 2023, to May 1, 2023, the House of Representatives and the Senate shall be open so the office of the Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives and the office of the Secretary of the Senate may receive communications, vetoes of
- 9 bills by the Governor, and notification of errors and oversights;
- 10 That the Regular Session of the Ninety-Fourth General Assembly of 11 the State of Arkansas shall enter into recess simultaneously at the close of 12 business in each chamber on April 7, 2023, or at such earlier time as may be agreed upon by the House of Representatives and the Senate; 13
- 14 (d) That the Speaker of the House of Representatives and the President Pro Tempore of the Senate may, by joint proclamation: 15
- 16 (1) Reconvene the General Assembly at any time before 12:00 17 noon, May 1, 2023, for the purpose of:
- 18 (A) Considering vetoes;
- 19 (B) Correcting errors and oversights;
- 20 (C) Completing its work on proposed constitutional
- 21 amendments; and
- 22 (D) Considering the need for further extension of the
- 23 Regular Session of the Ninety-Fourth General Assembly; or
- 24 (2) Adjourn the Regular Session of the Ninety-Fourth General
- 25 Assembly at any time before 12:00 noon, May 1, 2023, if they determine it is 26 not necessary to reconvene; and
- 27 That if the General Assembly is not reconvened or adjourned before 12:00 noon, May 1, 2023, the Regular Session of the Ninety-Fourth General 28 29 Assembly is adjourned sine die on that date.
