ASSUMPTIONS - BASED ON:

- √ * \$300K statewide costs (87 locations) for hardware, supplies, installation, and system training. Absorption by SOS is unclear.
- √ Incremental SOS costs for outreach and voter education are expected to be zero; if not, they will be absorbed.

ADDITIONAL COMMENTS

- √ * DFA revenues associated with identification cards could reflect minor fiscal impact.
- √ A poll of all county clerks performed by the Association of Arkansas Counties reflects no incremental fiscal impact expected by the counties.
