Bill Subtitle: TO REPEAL THE REQUIREMENT THAT A PARENT OR GUARDIAN WAIT BEFORE WITHDRAWING HIS OR HER CHILD FROM A SCHOOL DISTRICT; AND TO REPEAL THE REQUIREMENT THAT A PARENT OR GUARDIAN STATE HIS OR HER CHILD'S INTENT TO SEEK A DRIVER'S LICENSE.

Basic Change :

Sponsors: Reps. Lowery and C. Cooper

House Amendment No. 1 --- HB1429-H1 (engrossed 3/3/2021) revises the in-semester home school notice requirement to withdraw from public school from fourteen (14) to five (5) calendar days; conditions in-semester eligibility for home schooling upon the return of or payment for educational material temporarily provided by a public school; and allows the public school to waive the five-day notification period if satisfied the temporarily supplied educational materials have been returned.

Original Bill --- HB1429 would repeal the requirements to provide: (1) a fourteen-calendar-day notice to provide home schooling; and (2) notice of a student's plans to seek a driver's license within the current school year.

A parent or guardian would no longer be required to include within a home school notification his or her child's intent to seek a driver's license.
