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23	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code §§ 17-87-101 and 17-87-102 are a	mended to
24	read as follows:	
25	17-87-101. License required — Purpose.	
26	(a) In order to safeguard life and health, any <u>a</u> person p	racticing or
27	offering to practice nursing for compensation shall be required	to submit
28	evidence that he or she is qualified to so practice and shall be	e licensed as
29	provided in this chapter:	
30	(1) Professional nursing;	
31	(2) Advanced practice <u>registered</u> nursing;	
32	(3) Registered practitioner nursing;	
33	(4) Practical nursing; or	
34	(5) Psychiatric technician nursing.	
35	(b) It shall be <u>is</u> unlawful for any person not licensed b	y the board:
36	(1) To practice or offer to practice professional m	ursing,



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advanced practice registered nursing, registered practitioner nursing,

2 practical nursing, or psychiatric technician nursing; or

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8 9 SECTION 2. 17-87-102. Definitions. As used in this chapter:

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(1) "Board" means the Arkansas State Board of Nursing;

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(2) "Collaborative practice agreement" means a written plan that identifies a physician who agrees to collaborate with an advanced practice <u>registered</u> nurse in the joint management of the health care of the advanced practice <u>registered</u> nurse's patients, and outlines procedures for consultation with or referral to the collaborating physician or other health care professionals as indicated by a patient's health care needs;

17 (3) "Consulting physician" means a physician licensed under the 18 Arkansas Medical Practices Act, § 17-95-201 et seq., § 17-95-301 et seq., and 19 § 17-95-401 et seq., with obstetrical privileges in a hospital, who has 20 agreed to practice in consultation with a certified nurse midwife;

(4) (A) "Practice of advanced practice <u>registered</u> nursing" means the delivery of health care services for compensation by professional nurses who have gained additional knowledge and skills through successful completion of an organized program of nursing education that certifies nurses for advanced practice roles as <u>advanced certified</u> nurse practitioners, certified nurse anesthetists, certified nurse midwives, and clinical nurse specialists.

(B)(i) "Practice of advanced <u>certified</u> nurse practitioner
nursing" means the performance for compensation of nursing skills by a
registered nurse who, as demonstrated by national certification, has advanced
knowledge and practice skills in the delivery of nursing services.

(ii)(a) "Practice of certified registered nurse anesthesia" means the performance for compensation of advanced nursing skills relevant to the administration of anesthetics under the supervision of, but not necessarily in the presence of, a licensed physician, licensed dentist, or other person lawfully entitled to order anesthesia.

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(b) A certified registered nurse anesthetist

1 may order nurses, within their his or her scope of practice, to administer 2 drugs preoperatively and postoperatively in connection with an anesthetic or 3 other operative or invasive procedure, or both, that will be or has been 4 provided.

5 (iii) "Practice of clinical nurse specialist 6 nursing" means the performance for compensation of nursing skills by a 7 registered nurse who, through study and supervised practice at the graduate 8 level and as evidenced by national certification, has advanced knowledge and 9 practice skills in a specialized area of nursing practice;

(iv) "Practice of <u>certified</u> nurse midwifery" means the performance for compensation of nursing skills relevant to the management of women's health care, focusing on pregnancy, childbirth, the postpartum period, care of the newborn, family planning, and gynecological needs of women, within a health care system that provides for consultation, collaborative management, or referral as indicated by the health status of the client;

17 (5) "Practice of practical nursing" means the performance for 18 compensation of acts involving the care of the ill, injured, or infirm or the 19 delegation of certain nursing practices to other personnel as set forth in 20 regulations established by the board under the direction of a registered 21 professional professional registered nurse, an advanced practice registered 22 nurse, a licensed physician, or a licensed dentist, which acts do not require 23 the substantial specialized skill, judgment, and knowledge required in 24 professional nursing;

25 (6) "Practice of professional nursing" means the performance for 26 compensation of any acts involving:

27 (A) The observation, care, and counsel of the ill,
28 injured, or infirm;
20 (B) The print property of health or properties of illness.

29 (B) The maintenance of health or prevention of illness of
30 others;
31 (C) The supervision and teaching of other personnel;

32 (D) The delegation of certain nursing practices to other 33 personnel as set forth in regulations established by the board; or 34 (E) The administration of medications and treatments as 35 prescribed by practitioners authorized to prescribe and treat in accordance

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with state law when such acts require substantial specialized judgment and

skill based on knowledge and application of the principles of biological,
 physical, and social sciences;

(7) "Practice of psychiatric technician nursing" means the 3 4 performance for compensation of acts involving the care of the physically and 5 mentally ill, retarded, impaired person injured, or infirm or the delegation 6 of certain nursing practices to other personnel as set forth in regulations 7 established by the board, and the carrying out of medical orders under the 8 direction of a registered professional registered nurse, an advanced practice 9 registered nurse, a licensed physician, or a licensed dentist, when such 10 activities do not require the substantial specialized skill, judgment, and 11 knowledge required in professional nursing; and

12 (8)(A) "Practice of registered nurse practitioner nursing" means 13 the delivery of health care services for compensation in collaboration with 14 and under the direction of a licensed physician or under the direction of 15 protocols developed with a licensed physician.

16 (B) Registered nurse practitioners shall be <u>A registered</u>
 17 <u>nurse practitioner is</u> authorized to engage in activities as recognized by the
 18 nursing profession and as authorized by the board.

19 (C) Nothing in this subdivision (8) is to be deemed to
20 This subdivision (8) does not limit a registered nurse practitioner from
21 engaging in those activities which that normally constitute the practice of
22 nursing, or those which activities that may be performed by persons without
23 the necessity of the license to practice medicine.

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25 SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 17-87-103(10), concerning exceptions to the 26 nurse practice act, is amended to read as follows:

27 The prescription and administration of drugs, medicines, or (10)28 therapeutic devices in the presence of and under the supervision of an 29 advanced practice registered nurse holding a certificate of prescriptive 30 authority, a licensed physician, or licensed dentist by a registered nurse 31 who is enrolled as a student in an advanced pharmacology course, provided the 32 prescription or administration of drugs or medicines, or both, is confined to 33 the educational requirements of the course and under the direct supervision 34 of a qualified instructor;

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SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 17-87-103(12)(B)(iii), concerning

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1 exceptions to the nurse practice act, is amended to read as follows: 2 (iii) "Health maintenance activities" means 3 activities that: 4 Enable a minor child or adult to live in (a) 5 his or her home; and 6 (b) Are beyond activities of daily living 7 that: 8 The minor child or adult is unable (1)9 to perform for himself or herself; and 10 The attending physician, advanced (2) practice <u>registered</u> nurse, or registered nurse determines can be safely 11 12 performed in the minor child's or adult's home by a designated care aide 13 under the direction of a competent adult or caretaker. 14 15 SECTION 5. Arkansas Code § 17-87-104(a)(1)(D)(iii), concerning 16 penalties under the nurse practice act, is amended to read as follows: 17 (iii) Advanced practice nurse, advanced practice 18 registered nurse, or A.P.N., or A.P.R.N, or any of the following: 19 (a) Advanced registered nurse practitioner, 20 certified nurse practitioner, A.R.N.P., or A.N.P., or C.N.P.; 21 (b) Nurse anesthetist, certified nurse 22 anesthetist, certified registered nurse anesthetist, or C.R.N.A.; 23 (c) Nurse midwife, certified nurse midwife, 24 licensed nurse midwife, C.N.M., or L.N.M.; or 25 (d) Clinical nurse specialist or C.N.S.; 26 27 SECTION 6. Arkansas Code § 17-87-104(a)(1)(F), concerning penalties 28 under the nurse practice act, is amended to read as follows: 29 (F) Conduct a nursing education program for the 30 preparation of professional nurses, advanced practice registered nurses, 31 nurse practitioners, practical nurses, or psychiatric technician nurses 32 unless the program has been approved by the board; 33 SECTION 7. Arkansas Code § 17-87-201(c), concerning the membership of 34 35 the Arkansas State Board of Nursing, is amended to read as follows: 36 (c)(1) One (1) member shall be a licensed advanced practice registered

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1 nurse. 2 (2) The licensed advanced practice registered nurse board member 3 shall have the following qualifications: 4 (A) Be an Arkansas resident; 5 (B) Have at least five (5) years of experience as an 6 advanced practice registered nurse; 7 (C) Be licensed in Arkansas as an advanced practice 8 registered nurse; 9 (D) Have been actively engaged in nursing for at least 10 three (3) years immediately preceding appointment, two (2) of which shall 11 have been in Arkansas; and 12 (E) Have a certificate granting prescriptive authority. 13 14 SECTION 8. Arkansas Code § 17-87-201(j), concerning the terms of the 15 members of the Arkansas State Board of Nursing, is amended to read as 16 follows: 17 The terms of all registered nurse members and advanced practice (j) 18 registered nurse members shall be four (4) years. 19 20 SECTION 9. Arkansas Code § 17-87-203(8), concerning the powers and 21 duties of the Arkansas State Board of Nursing, is amended to read as follows: 22 (8) Prescribe minimum standards and approve curricula for 23 educational programs preparing persons for licensure as registered nurses, 24 advanced practice registered nurses, registered certified nurse practitioner 25 nurses, licensed practical nurses, and licensed psychiatric technician 26 nurses; 27 SECTION 10. Arkansas Code § 17-87-203(16), concerning the powers and 28 29 duties of the Arkansas State Board of Nursing, is amended to read as follows: 30 (16) Grant certificates of prescriptive authority to qualified 31 advanced practice registered nurses; 32 33 SECTION 11. Arkansas Code § 17-87-205(b), concerning the membership of the Prescriptive Authority Advisory Committee, is amended to read as follows: 34 35 (b) The board shall appoint $\frac{five}{(5)}$ six (6) members, to be approved 36 by the Governor, who have the following qualifications:

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1 (1) Three (3) Four (4) members shall be advanced practice 2 registered nurses holding at least three (3) of whom hold certificates of 3 prescriptive authority and an active Drug Enforcement Administration number; 4 (2) One (1) member shall be a licensed physician who has been 5 involved in a collaborative practice with $\frac{1}{2}$ an advanced practice registered 6 nurse practitioner for at least five (5) years; and 7 (3) One (1) member shall be a licensed pharmacist who has been 8 in practice licensed for at least five (5) years. 9 SECTION 12. Arkansas Code § 17-87-302 is amended to read as follows: 10 11 17-87-302. Advanced practice registered nurses. 12 (a) Qualifications. In order to be licensed as an advanced practice 13 registered nurse, an applicant must shall show evidence of education approved 14 by the Arkansas State Board of Nursing, and national certification approved 15 by the board under one (1) of the following role of an advanced practice 16 registered nurse: 17 (1) Advanced Registered Certified Nurse Practitioner. In order 18 to qualify as an advanced registered A certified nurse practitioner, an 19 applicant must be currently certified as a nurse practitioner by a nationally 20 recognized certifying body shall hold current certification by a national certifying body recognized by the board in the role of an advanced practice 21 22 registered nurse and population foci appropriate to educational preparation; 23 (2) Certified Registered Nurse Anesthetist. To qualify as a 24 certified registered nurse anesthetist, an applicant must shall: 25 (A) Have earned a diploma or certificate evidencing 26 satisfactory completion, beyond generic nursing preparation, of a formal 27 educational program that meets the standards of the Council on Accreditation 28 of Nurse Anesthesia Educational Programs or another nationally recognized 29 accrediting body and that has as its objective the preparation of nurses to 30 perform as nurse anesthetists; and 31 (B) Hold current certification from the Council on 32 Certification of Nurse Anesthetists, the Council on Recertification of Nurse 33 Anesthetists, or other nationally recognized certifying body by a national 34 certifying body recognized by the board in the role of an advanced practice 35 registered nurse and population foci appropriate to educational preparation; 36 (3) Certified Nurse Midwife. To qualify as a certified nurse

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1 midwife, an applicant must shall: 2 (A) Hold current certification as a nurse midwife from the 3 American College of Nurse Midwives or other nationally recognized certifying 4 body by a national certifying body recognized by the board in the role of an 5 advanced practice registered nurse and population foci appropriate to 6 educational preparation; and 7 (B) Have an agreement with a consulting physician if 8 providing intrapartum care; 9 (4) Clinical Nurse Specialist. In order to qualify as a 10 clinical nurse specialist, an applicant must shall: 11 (A) hold Hold a master's degree evidencing successful 12 completion of a graduate program in nursing, which shall include supervised 13 clinical practice and classroom instruction in a nursing specialty; and 14 (B) must be nationally certified in a specialty role as a 15 elinical nurse specialist Hold current certification by a national certifying body recognized by the board in the role of an advanced practice registered 16 17 nurse and population foci appropriate to educational preparation. 18 (b) Issuance of License. A license to practice as an advanced 19 practice registered nurse may be issued: 20 (1) By Application. Any person holding a license to practice 21 as a registered nurse and meeting the educational qualifications and 22 certification requirements to be licensed as an advanced practice registered 23 nurse, upon application and payment of necessary fees to the board, may be 24 licensed as an advanced practice registered nurse; and 25 (2) By Endorsement. The board may issue a license to practice 26 advanced practice registered nursing by endorsement to any applicant who has 27 been licensed as an advanced practice registered nurse or to a person 28 entitled to perform similar services under a different title under the laws 29 of another state, territory, or foreign country if, in the opinion of the board, the applicant meets the requirements for advanced practice registered 30 31 nurses in this state. 32 Any person who holds a license to (c) Title and Abbreviation. 33

33 practice as an advanced practice <u>registered</u> nurse shall have the right to use 34 the title of "advanced practice <u>registered</u> nurse" and the abbreviation 35 <u>"A.P.N."</u> <u>"A.P.R.N."</u>.

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SECTION 13. Arkansas Code § 17-87-307(d)(1), concerning temporary
 permits to practice professional, practical, or psychiatric technician
 nursing, is amended to read as follows:

4 (d)(1) Upon application and payment of the required fee, the board
5 shall issue a temporary permit to a qualified applicant holding a current
6 advanced practice <u>registered</u> nurse license or the equivalent from another
7 jurisdiction from any other state or territory awaiting endorsement.

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9 SECTION 14. Arkansas Code § 17-87-308(g), concerning renewal of
10 nursing licenses, is amended to read as follows:

(g) As a condition of licensure renewal, an advanced practice <u>registered</u> nurse shall submit proof of current national certification and successful completion of continuing education as required by the board.

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SECTION 15. Arkansas Code § 17-87-310 is amended to read as follows: 17-87-310. Prescriptive authority.

17 (a) The Arkansas State Board of Nursing may grant a certificate of
18 prescriptive authority to an advanced practice <u>registered</u> nurse who:

19 (1) Submits proof of successful completion of a board-approved
20 advanced pharmacology course that shall include preceptorial experience in
21 the prescription of drugs, medicines, and therapeutic devices; and

(2) Has a collaborative practice agreement with a physician who
is licensed under the Arkansas Medical Practices Act, § 17-95-201 et seq., §
17-95-301 et seq., and § 17-95-401 et seq., and who has a practice comparable
in scope, specialty, or expertise to that of the advanced practice <u>registered</u>
nurse on file with the Arkansas State Board of Nursing.

(b)(1) An advanced practice <u>registered</u> nurse with a certificate of prescriptive authority may receive and prescribe drugs, medicines, or therapeutic devices appropriate to the advanced practice <u>registered</u> nurse's area of practice in accordance with rules established by the Arkansas State Board of Nursing.

32 (2) An advanced practice <u>registered</u> nurse's prescriptive
 33 authority shall only extend to drugs listed in Schedules III - V.

34 (c) A collaborative practice agreement shall include, but not be35 limited to, provisions addressing:

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(1) The availability of the collaborating physician for

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- consultation or referral, or both;

2 (2) Methods of management of the collaborative practice, which3 shall include protocols for prescriptive authority;

4 (3) Coverage of the health care needs of a patient in the
5 emergency absence of the advanced practice <u>registered</u> nurse or physician; and
6 (4) Quality assurance.

7 (d) If a collaborative practice results in complaints of violations of 8 the Arkansas Medical Practices Act, § 17-95-201 et seq., § 17-95-301 et seq., 9 and § 17-95-401 et seq., the Arkansas State Medical Board may review the role 10 of the physician in the collaborative practice to determine if the physician 11 is unable to manage his or her responsibilities under the agreement without 12 an adverse effect on the quality of care of the patient.

(e) If a collaborative practice results in complaints of violations of this chapter, the Arkansas State Board of Nursing may review the role of the advanced practice <u>registered</u> nurse in the collaborative practice to determine if the nurse is unable to manage his or her responsibilities under the agreement without an adverse effect on the quality of care of the patient.

19 SECTION 16. Arkansas Code § 17-87-311(a), concerning nurse's direct 20 reimbursement agreements, is amended to read as follows:

(a) An advanced practice <u>registered</u> nurse or a registered nurse
 practitioner may enter into a direct reimbursement agreement with the agency
 administering the state medicaid program.

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
