## **PROCLAMATION**

- WHEREAS, House Concurrent Resolution 1010 (HCR 1010) of the Regular Session of the Ninety-First General Assembly provided for a recess of the session on or before April 7, 2017; and
- WHEREAS, HCR 1010 authorized the Speaker of the House and the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, by Joint Proclamation, to reconvene the General Assembly at any time before 12:00 Noon, May 5, 2017, for the purpose of considering vetoes; correcting errors and oversights; completing its work on proposed constitutional amendments; considering the need for further extension of the Regular Session of the Ninety-First General Assembly; or to adjourn the Regular Session sine die.
- NOW THEREFORE, We, the undersigned Speaker of the House and President Pro Tempore of the Senate, of the Regular Session of the Ninety-First General Assembly of Arkansas, pursuant to provisions of HCR 1010, hereby direct that the Regular Session of the Ninety-First General Assembly of the State of Arkansas shall reconvene at 1:00 p.m., Monday, May 1, 2017, for the following purpose:
  - 1) To adjourn the Ninety-First General Assembly Regular Session Sine Die.
