HB1327	Allen	TO PROTECT CONSUMERS OF MOTOR VEHICLES BY REQUIRING THE SELLER TO DISCLOSE WHETHER THE MOTOR VEHICLE IS FROM METHAMPEHTAMINE-RELATED SEIZURE.
HB1397	J. Edwards	TO AUTHORIZE GOVERNMENT-OWNED AND GOVERNMENT-OPERATED STORAGE FACILITIES FOR MOTOR VEHICLES TO REQUIRE PROOF OF INSURANCE BEFORE RELEASING IMPOUNDED VEHICLES.
HB1423	Carroll	TO ENSURE THAT HEADLIGHTS OR HEADLAMPS FOR USE ON MOTOR VEHICLES ARE NOT USED OR SOLD IN ARKANSAS IF THEIR BRIGHTNESS OR INTENSITY ARE A SAFETY HAZARD OR OTHERWISE DO NOT COMPLY WITH FEDERAL SPECIFICATIONS.
HB1437	L. Cowling	TO REQUIRE VEHICLE IDENTIFICATION NUMBER VERIFICATION FOR ISSUANCE OF TITLE ON REPOSSESSED MOTOR VEHICLE.
HB1438	L. Cowling	TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF PARTS ONLY TITLES TO INSURERS.
HB1455	Moore	TO CLARIFY THAT A PERMIT FOR EARTHMOVING EQUIPMENT MAY ALLOW THE TOWING OF TWO DIRT PANS AT ONE TIME.
