SB125	Hendren	TO CLARIFY THE PROCEDURE FOR UPDATING THE VEHICLE INSURANCE DATABASE.
SB950	Hendren	TO ALLOW THE OFFICE OF MOTOR VEHICLE TO IMPOSE A FINE IF A PERSON ALLOWS HIS OR HER REQUIRED MOTOR VEHICLE INSURANCE TO LAPSE.
