SB299	Teague	TO AMEND THE SALES AND USE TAX EXEMPTION FOR TIMBER HARVESTING MACHINERY, EQUIPMENT, AND RELATED ATTACHMENTS; AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY.
SB300	J. Dismang	TO PROVIDE COMPENSATION FOR WORK DONE TO TAX-DELINQUENT LANDS TO PREVENT DETERIORATION OR TO COMPLY WITH CODE REQUIREMENTS.
