<u>SB9</u>	T. Garner	GRANTING A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER EMPLOYED WITH THE SOCIAL SECURITY ADMINISTRATION THE AUTHORITY TO ARREST.
<u>SB82</u>	A. Clark	TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING REPORTS FILED WITH THE COURT BEFORE A HEARING HELD UNDER THE ARKANSAS JUVENILE CODE OF 1989.
<u>SB83</u>	A. Clark	CONCERNING EVIDENCE PRESENTED IN CERTAIN JUVENILE HEARINGS; TO AMEND THE REQUIREMENTS FOR UNSUPERVISED VISITATION; AND TO ALLOW SANCTIONS FOR NONCOMPLIANCE WITH CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF THE ARKANSAS JUVENILE CODE OF 1989.
