Good Afternoon. I draft the appropriation bills for the Constitutional officers and found in Act 869 of 2019, there was mention of the Arkansas Citizens First Responder Safety Enhancement Fund. What I am inquiring about is from Section 2 of Section 24, there is language stating that the Director of the Department of Finance and Administration would notify Legislative Council and the Director of the Bureau of Legislative Research that the first \$15 dollars of a fine assessed under § 27-22-103(a) or § 27-22-103(b) may be paid to the Treasurer of State for the benefit of the Arkansas Citizens First Responder Safety Enhancement Fund. I am needing to know two things and I hope that you can answer them or direct me to the correct person:

1. Has the first \$15 of a fine been assessed and paid to the Treasurer of State for the Arkansas Citizens First Responder Safety Enhancement Fund?
2. When I pull reports to see where this is being applied, is it going to be under Proof of Insurance – Fines & Penalties or will it be given its own individual line item?

SECTION 24. TEMPORARY LANGUAGE. Contingent effective date.

Section 2 and Section 5 of this act are effective on and after the date the Director of the Department of Finance and Administration and the advisory group established under § 27-22-203:

(1) Determine that the online insurance verification system established under the Arkansas Online Insurance Verification System Act, § 27-22-201 et seq. is fully operational; and

**(2) Notify the Legislative Council and the Director of the Bureau of Legislative Research that the first fifteen dollars (\$15.00) of a fine assessed under § 27-22-103(a) or § 27-22-103(b) may be paid to the Treasurer of State for the benefit of the Arkansas Citizens First Responder Safety Enhancement Fund.**
