Discussion of Emergency Rule Request

Pursuant to Act 1258 of 2015, the Executive Subcommittee considered the following emergency rule regarding the List of Controlled Substances for the Arkansas Department of Health, which was presented by Laura Shue, General Counsel for the Arkansas Department of Health.

Following the discussion, Co-Chair Dotson stated that without objection, the proposed emergency rule is reviewed and approved, and the review and approval shall be effective upon adjournment of the meeting of the Legislative Council Friday, October 19, 2018.

Director's Report

Director Marty Garrity delivered her Director's Report and stated that the Bureau is moving forward with Sliq Media Technologies to provide streaming in Committee Rooms A and B of the Big Mac Building. She also advised that the members private Wi-Fi services were beginning to run slower due to the increased number of users and that members' passwords will change prior to the legislative session. Director Garrity also discussed the law that would allow a state agency to recycle computer and other electronic equipment, and the subcommittee determined that the deadline had passed for an agency to file a new policy with the Legislative Council.
