Contract Summary

This outline agreement is intended to bridge that gap and account for all work tied to COVID-19 methods &/or tasks as they relate to COVID-19 specimen receiving and processing, including technical and analytical tasks, and working with a Biosafety Cabinet and the handling of SARS-CoV-2 (COVID-19) patient samples. The PHL is required to support all COVID-19 testing efforts, twenty-four (24) hours a day, seven (7) days per week, with the expectation of three hundred and sixty-five (365) days per year and/or until the pandemic is deemed over. To met this mandate, the PHL must have specimen receiving, data-entry and testing labs continuously open, with enough BSCs operational to sustain full capacity at all times. There are a total of six (6) biosafety cabinets (BSCs) utilized for COVID-19 specimen receiving
