Below is a list of the grantees and amounts recommended to receive 2015 Electronic Waste Grants from the Arkansas Computer and Electronic Solid Waste Management Act, Acts 1410 of 2001 and 970 of 2005, codified as A.C.A. 25-34-101.

This year nine applications were submitted seeking a total of \$300,815.48 in state funds. The amount available in the 2015 grant cycle is \$117,000.00. Utilizing the Application Evaluation Criteria I recommend eight of the nine receive full or partial funding. The one application I do not recommend receiving state funds is the application made by an individual for an art project.
