In response to the USGS FY2016 National Geological and Geophysical Data Preservation Program (NGGDPP) grant announcement, the Arkansas Geological Survey (AGS) developed a plan that includes preserving 4 different collections: 80 maps, 7 written media collections, 4 photograph portfolios, and approximately 700 geologic field photographs. The plan includes 4 steps: inventory, cleaning, scanning, and preservation of original copies. In addition, materials will be purchased to properly prevent further deterioration. The collection will be converted to a digital format to ensure long term preservation. Metadata will be generated for each map, book, photograph, and for the collection as a whole. All documents will be made available to the public digitally in document format via the Agency's website.
