The Arkansas Department of Education, Division of Elementary and Secondary Education (DESE) requests an increase in cash fund appropriation for the Multiple Grant Award Program.

This increase will accommodate a grant received by the Walton Foundation. The grant will support implementation of high quality, rigorous tier 1 mathematics curriculum in middle and high schools across the state. Funds will be allocated to LEAs for curriculum materials and teacher training and support to implement the curriculum with fidelity.
