Please accept this letter as a request for additional Cash in Treasury appropriation for fiscal year 2021 as follows:

In September 2020, ADFA completed a refunding and construction bond issue for the expansion of the Justice Building. The new Series 2020 bond in the amount of \$14,620,000 will fund the building's expansion project expected to begin in June, 2021. The debt service payments for the new series are Interest only payments in June and Principal and interest in December of each fiscal year. The first interest payment for the new bond series will be June, 2021 in the amount of \$362,939.31.

The current fiscal year (FY21) appropriation did not anticipate the new issue's draw on funds for the bond refunding and therefore depleted the fiscal year appropriation not leaving sufficient appropriation for the fiscal year. Otherwise, the annual budgeted appropriation is sufficient for future fiscal years with debt service and fees less than \$900,000 annually.
