AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF ARKANSAS STATE POLICE APPROPRIATION FOR THE 2018-2019

Amendment No. ___ to House Bill No. 1080

Amend House Bill No. 1080 as originally introduced:

Page 12, line 23, insert a new section immediately following Section 20 to read as follows:

" SECTION 21. SPECIAL LANGUAGE - CODE AMENDMENT. Arkansas Code § 5-73-311(a)(2), concerning the fees for a license to carry a concealed handgun, is amended to read as follows:

(2) A nonrefundable license fee of ~~one hundred dollars (\$100)~~ fifty dollars (\$50.00), except that the nonrefundable license fee is ~~fifty dollars (\$50.00)~~ twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) if the applicant is sixty-five (65) years of age or older;"

AND

Appropriately renumber the subsequent Sections of the bill.

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

22 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the
23 Department of Arkansas State Police for the 2018-2019 fiscal year, the
24 following maximum number of regular employees.

1 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. ARKANSAS
2 WIRELESS INFORMATION NETWORK. Once the requirements of Arkansas Code §12-8-
3 310 are satisfied, the second two million five hundred thousand dollars
4 (\$2,500,000) deposited into the Department of Arkansas State Police Fund
5 generated by Arkansas Code §27-16-801(a) shall be used for the operations,
6 maintenance, equipment and various system requirements and expenses of the
7 Department of Arkansas State Police - Arkansas Wireless Information Network.

8 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2017~~
9 2018 through June 30, ~~2018~~ 2019.

10
11 SECTION 20. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
12 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. QUARTERLY
13 REPORTING. The Department of Arkansas State Police shall on a quarterly basis
14 provide to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee a
15 report detailing expenditures from the Court Awards Fund of the Confiscated
16 Funds Transfer appropriation of this Act. The report shall include the State
17 Police division, purpose and amount of expenditures.

18 The quarterly reports shall be provided no later than the 15th day of the
19 month immediately following the end of each quarter.

20 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2017~~
21 2018 through June 30, ~~2018~~ 2019.

23 → SECTION 21. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
24 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
25 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
26 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
27 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
28 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
29 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
30 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
31 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

33 SECTION 22. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
34 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
35 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
36 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
